Subject: 911 Dispatch Center Furniture Agreement with Goodmans Inc., dba Goodmans Interior Structures

The city's 911-dispatch center will be undergoing renovations this fiscal year. Part of the renovation will be to install new workstations for the telecommunications staff and supervisor. Staff anticipates the installation to start at the beginning of March 2021. The 911-dispatch center will receive:

1. 7 dispatch workstations with height adjustable tables
2. 8 work chairs
3. 1 Meeting area with a mobile table
4. Storage/filing cabinets at the workstations
5. Additional counter space for printers and a radio charging station
6. Supervisor office will receive an adjustable height table, desk, 2 guest chairs, table and a storage tower

Staff respectfully requests entering into an agreement with Goodmans, Inc. dba Goodmans Interior Structures for the installation of new workstations for the 911-dispatch center in the amount not to exceed \$88,138.85.
