Process

Pre-Application

- Internal Meeting with either City Engineer or Public Works Director
- Right-of-Way Research
 - Verify that no parcel will be land locked
 - Verify all Federal Patent Easements & Dedicated Rights-of-Way



- Completed Application Form (Notarized)
- Support Petition from all abutting property owners
- Proof of Property Ownership (deed, assessor records, etc)
- Limited Realty Guarantee
- Written Statement for Extinguishment/Vacation
- Proposition 207 Forms (Notarized)
- Drawing/Map/Sketch
- Non-refundable Application Fee (\$350)
- Verify all existing Federal Patent Easements and Dedicated Right-of-Way



Process (cont'd)

- Utility and Emergency Responder Notification
 - Send an exhibit requesting response for roadway easement extinguishment only. If no response then send second request with 2 week turn around.




