Subject: Contract No. HFS21-11 Award

City staff respectfully requests city council consideration of award of contract no. HFS21-11 to Franklin Striping for street striping services. Work within the term of the agreement will consist of restriping the city's 208 lane miles of long-striping and pavement markings (arrows, crosswalks, stop bars, etc.). These streets are striped at a frequency of 1.5 times per year to keep up with retro-reflectivity safety standards with some streets more frequent than others depending on street's condition and extent of street maintenance projects. Term of this contract would extend into 2023 and not exceed \$200,000 per annum. Average annual cost to restripe the city's streets is approximately \$170,000 per year and is budgeted through the city's Highway Users Revenue Funds ("HURF").
