Subject: Project #: HFS21-15 Award

City staff respectfully requests city council consideration of award of contract to Viasun Corporation for project HFS21-15 for the service of crushing asphalt concrete and screening. This work is included in the FY 2022 Street Capital Improvement & Maintenance Plan to produce aggregate used for street maintenance and pavement preservation projects.

The work would take place in the Public Works yard late this summer into fall. Work would be up to a not to exceed amount of \$308,096.00 equating to approximately 20,000 tons of asphalt being crushed and sized. The asphalt to be crushed is asphalt recovered from roads recently reconstructed or re-paved within the city. Public Works customarily recycles and crushes its reclaimed asphalt every four to six years. Crushed asphalt has been used primarily in the maintenance of our rural roads' dirt shoulders, dirt roads, alleys, and also more recently as aggregate in some slurry seals and chip seals.
