WHAT WE DO...

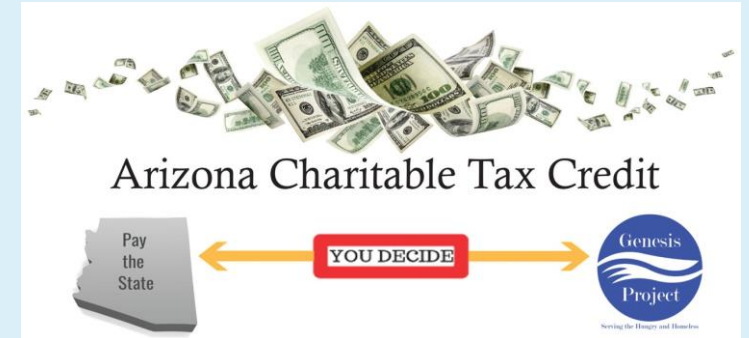
- Hot meals – average 137/day (May 2021)
- Shower vouchers – 12 vouchers/week and over 600 showers each year!
- Clothing bank and hygiene items - 26 people/day
- Drivers licenses/state identification/birth certificates* – 9 since 2020
- Hydration and heat relief location – 4.5 pallets of water distributed monthly
- Employment and training opportunities – employ 4 formerly, and 1 currently homeless persons
- Assisted 3 people with filing for unemployment benefits and 1 person file their tax return.
