In order for the District to match the City of Apache Junction's fiscal year coverage plan, he will be presenting a change including a six month term which will end June 30, 2021 and a new yearly plan that will begin July 1, 2021. This plan will be presented to the board in the coming month.

District Director Mike Loggins presented an overview on the Intergovernmental Agreement with Superstition Mountain Community Facilities District No. 1. The current agreement expires December 31, 2020. The new agreement will be for an additional five years and includes the rights to purchase long term storage credits.

District Director Mike Loggins presented an overview on the Superstition Area Water Plant Raw Water Impound Project.
